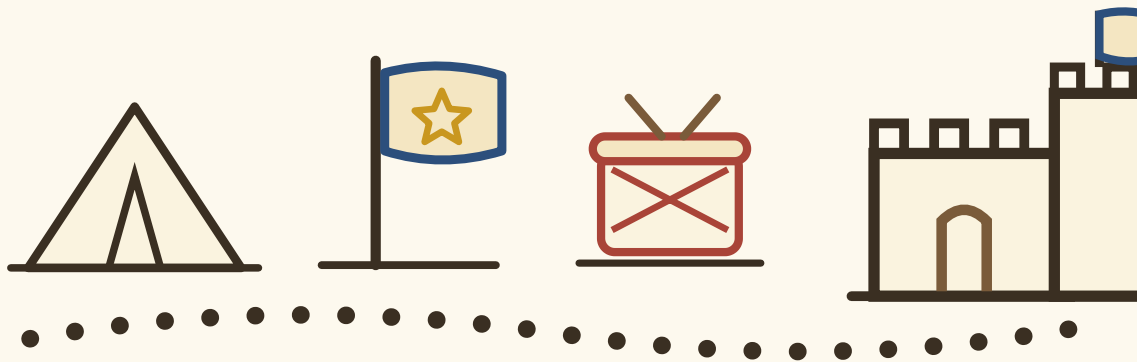

Liberty Letter Lines

Call-and-Trace Letter Missions



The parent calls a letter. The child points to it — then traces its route across the battlefield to a friendly goal.

Nine missions cover every uppercase letter, A to Z.

How to Play

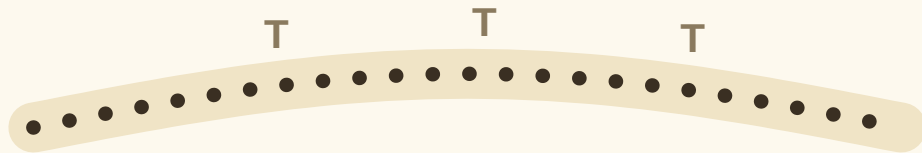
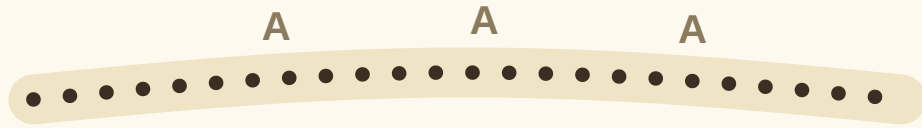
1. Pick one mission page and a crayon or broad pencil.
2. Say: “Find the letter M.” (Any letter on the page — any order.)
3. Ask your child to **point** to the letter before tracing.
4. If correct: “Yes — M! March along M’s line.” Trace camp to goal.
5. If missed, warmly name the choices — “This is M; this is T” — and try again. Never erase progress or keep score.
6. Do one to three routes per sitting — about three to five minutes.
7. Revisit pages often. A sheet protector and dry-erase crayon makes every page reusable.
8. Start with these uppercase missions; try lowercase letters only after uppercase feels easy.

Why point first, trace second?

Saying a letter’s name while your child finds its shape links the spoken label to the printed form — the heart of letter recognition. The broad dotted routes add relaxed pre-writing practice: big arm and hand movements, no precision traps, no grades. Short, playful, repeated sittings beat long drills. This pack is fictional storybook play inspired by the Revolutionary era — friendly flags, drums, and forts — not a historical battle diagram.

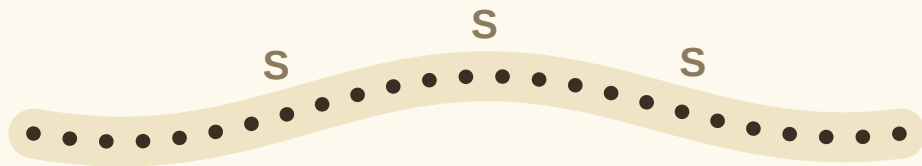
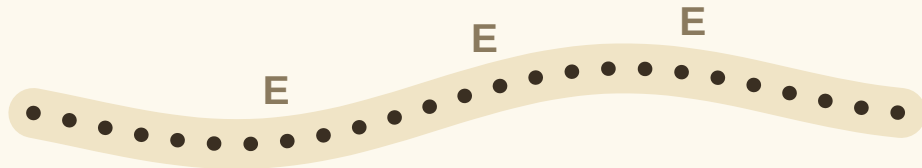
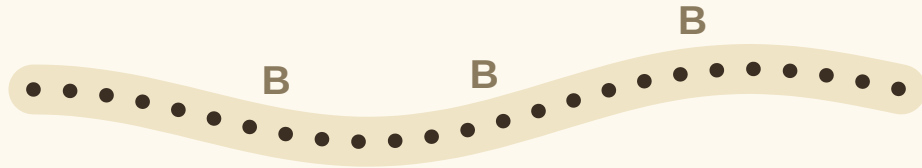
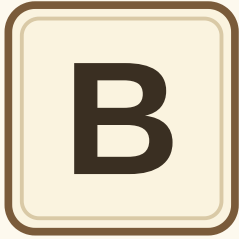
